Twine Outdoor Scrubbie



YOU'LL NEED: Size I (5.50) crochet hook Baling twine

Ch 13

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, ch 3, turn.

Row 2: dc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across, ch 3, turn.

Row 3: alternate fpdc and bpdc across, ch 3, turn.

Row 4–6: form ridges by following the previous rows' pattern of fp and bp dc, ch 3 at end of rows 4 and 5; at end of row 6, ch 1.

Row 7: sc in back loop only in 2nd st from hook and in each st across, ch 1, turn.

Row 8: sc in 2nd st from hook and in each st across, ch 1, turn.

Rows 9–15: repeat row 8.

Fold in half along row 7, sc around the outside edge of the entire scrubble. At the final corner, ch 10, sl st ch 10 to ch 1 to form a hanging loop. Fasten off.
